Shingle Lake Park - Find Your Joy Project

Lincoln Township is one of 29 Michigan Opportunity Communities whose economic opportunities and public health were deemed hardest hit by the Covid-19 pandemic, making us eligible to apply for a portion of \$24.2 million dollars made available through a partnership between the Council of Michigan Foundations and the DNR. Lincoln Township applied, and has been awarded \$772,700.00 for improvements to the Shingle Lake Park. Improvements include: Bathrooms, Playground equipment, and Pickle Ball/Basket Ball.

The Old School House Rehab Project

Larry Wyman, of the Stephenson Wyman Funeral Homes (Clare and Farwell) donated the School House to the township this summer. A Blight reduction grant has been awarded to the township through the County Land Bank for stabilization of the building, including roofing, windows, doors, clean up and razing the bus garage. The goal is to protect the historic building from further deterioration in order to preserve it for future purposeful use.

- The brick used in the construction of the building was produced in Clare Michigan.
- There are murals on the walls that I hope to have evaluated by the state historical society.

The Recycling Project

The recycle bins that lived in town across the street at the municipal parking for a couple years, have been moved to the compost field. The field is open M-F 8AM to noon, Sunday 9AM to noon and is accessible to carry in recycling anytime as we have removed a small portion of fencing to allow for a walk in pathway.

- The bins were moved due to misuse people leaving non-recyclable items, such as grills, clothing, appliances, paddle boat, furniture, and household trash all left sitting beside the bins for someone else to tend to.
- Non township residents and businesses using the bins for example, Stanley Painting out of Clare dump off 10 5 gallon paint buckets, some still with paint in them. We have that on camera.

Lynn Miller asked the township to partner with the LGPOA to try and secure curbside recycling through GFL. Rick Fancon from GFL we need to have a minimum 400 household's Township wide participate at \$7 per month in order for a curbside program to work. The township is sending out postcards about the program to all residents in the township who are currently on the tax roll for rubbish service (which means they have a livable dwelling). We will also be accepting participation from empty lot owners who wish to participate – mostly thinking of the campers in WBL. Post cards will likely be going out in the mail in October and we will put info about the program in the winter tax bills.
